Selectmen's Meeting
November 20, 2008 7pm @Town Hall
Minutes

Present: Selectmen Jack Plumley, Zoe Cowett, Lee Holman; Town Clerk Lianne Bedard; Transfer Station attendant Gale Williams; Reporter Mary Standard; residents Sara Lelamand and family, David Bowen, Kevin Ryan.

- I. Jack called the meeting to order at 7pm
- II. Reports
 - A. Road Report: Selectmen reviewed the road report.
 - B. CEO Report: Selectmen reviewed one building permit.
 - C. ACO Report: none
- III. Old Business
 1. Road Name/Gurney Hill area: Jack motioned to keep the section of road from Roger Gammons to Swan Pond Rd. intersection, left toward Meeting House Hill Cemetery and beyond the cemetery as Gurney Hill Road. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
 2. Transfer Station/Gail Williams: Jack motioned to have Gale Williams recycle the metal at the transfer station and allow him to keep the compensation he receives until the market changes (Gale had previously offered, on June 19, 2008, to split the compensation received for the metal with the Town of Hartford). Lee second. All in favor=3. Gale offered \$10.00/ton for the recycling of the steel drums at the transfer station. Gale will cut them up this winter and recycle them.
 3. Revised Subdivision Regulations: Jack motioned to accept the changes to the subdivision ordinance as written to be placed on the warrant for the special town meeting on December 13, 2008. Lee second. All in favor=3. Selectmen signed a certification of the wording of the ordinance.
 4. Town Meeting Warrant: Selectmen signed the warrant for the special town meeting to be held December 13, 2008, 9am at the Hartford Town Hall.
 5. Cemetery records online: Jack motioned to purchase the Richard Bedford book of cemeteries to donate to a MOCA volunteer who has offered to place the information online. Lee second. All in favor=3.
 6. CEO Position: Selectmen will conduct interviews on December 11 beginning at 6pm. Lianne is to set up interviews.
- IV. Open Session: Sara Lalemand was granted permission from the Board of Selectmen to install CMP poles along Gurney Hill Rd from Roger Gammons to the turn before the Meeting House Hill Cemetery as long as John Sharratt allows pole placement on the easement which runs through his property. Lianne reported that all citations issued from the Dept. of Labor have been corrected except the one issue of installing a barrier in front of the oil tank at the town office so that the snow plow or a customer cannot hit and damage the
