Selectmen's Meeting
April 5, 2012
Minutes

Present: Selectmen John Plumley, Lee Holman, Zoe Cowett, Town Clerk Lianne Bedard, and reporter Mary Standard.

I. Lee called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

II. Reports

- A. Road report: Lee reported that the posted signs have been removed from all roads and James has begun grading the gravel roads.
- B. CEO report: Selectmen reviewed two building permits.
- C. ACO report: Selectmen signed the unlicensed dog warrant.
- D. Planning board report: none.

III. Unfinished business

- 1. County tax commitment: Selectmen signed the county tax commitment papers. Hartford's share will be \$88,593.00.

IV. Open session

- 1. Lee motioned to allow a church group from New York to use the Hartford beach while staying in town June 26-30. Zoe second. All in favor=3. The group will be splitting wood for the Hartford community church wood bank for Hartford residents while they are here. The chaperones of the group must pickup guest passes at the town office.
- 2. Transportation survey is to be placed on the next agenda.
- 3. Lee motioned to use the old computer for the RSMS and house the computer wherever convenient. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
- 4. Lee reported on a discussion with Dan Jasper concerning plans for the town.
- 5. John requested that Lianne contact O'Donnell's about delaying the revaluation process until 2020.
- 6. Selectmen agreed to meet with the Appeals board on April 20th concerning the poverty abatement appeal application.

V. New business

- 1. Appointments: Lee motioned to appoint Leslie Boness to the Budget committee since David Bowen has not attended any meetings and deemed resigned. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
Lee motioned to appoint Mary Judd, Roxanne Caron, Cathy Lowe, Pauline Chasse, Vickielynn Kimball, Arthur Harvey, Arlene Nason, Carol Perry, Daryl Boness, Morrill Nason Jr., Doreen Maxwell, Judith Hamilton, Margaret Poskus, Stephanie Frobese and Leslie Boness as ballot clerks for a term of two years. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
- 2. Concealed weapon background checks: Selectmen signed two permit forms.
- 3. Dam advisory committee: Selectmen felt that no money should be raised for dam maintenance in 2012-2013. Lee appointed Donald Daigle as Interlocal Dam advisory committee member. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
- 4. County hazard mitigation plan update. Table

6. Maintenance of Salt shed and generator: Selectmen felt that a dealer should service and inspect the generator regularly. Tabled. Lee will speak with the maintenance person about performing maintenance on the salt shed.
