Selectmen's meeting
December 6, 2013
Minutes

7pm @ Hartford town office

Present: Selectmen John Plumley, Lee Holman, Zoe Cowett, Town Clerk Lianne Bedard, Planning Board members Morrill Nason, Arthur Harvey, Road Commissioner Jeremy Johnson and reporter Tom Standard.

- I. Lee called the meeting to order at 7:02pm
- II. Reports
 - a. Road report: Selectmen agreed to allow Jeremy to spend up to 18,147.00 on the Gurney Road project. Jeremy will inspect the water runoff problem on Berry Road and will bring the excavator to Hartford Center Cemetery to pull trees out so they may be removed.
 - b. CEO report: none
 - c. ACO report: Ozzie Hart submitted verification of an advanced training he completed.
 - d. Planning Board report: Morrill reported that the board has made two recent site visits.
 - e. RSU 10 Director report: none
- III. Unfinished business
 1. Special town meeting warrant: Lee spoke with Linda Butler of DEP who stated that if we decided to place bins in at a location once per month a chain link fence would be needed and gravel. Linda stated that this would not be considered a transfer station and would not require license fees. Lee spoke with AVCOG about selling the current transfer station property and they suggested keeping the land for timber harvesting. Lee will contact forester Merle Ring to set up a site visit at the property. Lee stated that the transfer station building will have to be removed and the site cleaned up and there will be a cost of \$200-500 for DEP to close the transfer station. Selectmen decided to remove the special town meeting article concerning allowing bins to be placed at a location monthly. Selectmen signed the warrant.
 2. Selectmen's letter/bulk mailing: Lee will work on letter and send it to Lianne for the mailing.
 3. GETS Card: Lee motioned to apply for one GETS Card to be used in an emergency. John second. All in favor=3.
- IV. Open session

1. Arthur contacted MMA Legal concerning the Duguay shed renovation.
 2. Lee stated that Linda Butler suggested holding curbside bulky waste pickup for certain areas of the town on one day and other parts on another day to prevent out of town people from dumping items at homes. She also suggested requiring each household to obtain a permit from the town office in order to leave items out at curbside.

 2. Ordinance Committee/updated ordinance list: Tabled until February
- VI. Lee motioned to approve the 11/15/12 Selectmen minutes. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
- VII. Lee motioned to approve Warrants 37, 38, 39, & 40. John second. All in favor=3.

- IX. Lee motioned to adjourn at 9:10pm.
