Present: Selectmen Jack Plumley, Zoe Cowett, Lee Holman Budget Committee members Neil Hanley, Dan Maddox, Leslie Boness, David Bowen, Bob L'Heureux, Road Commissioner Jeremy Johnson, CEO Bill Kennedy, Deputy Peggy Poskus, Town Clerk Lianne Bedard, residents Bob Calawa, Beverly Murphy, Judy Hamilton, Tom Hamilton, Grace Goodrow, John Bernier, and candidate Lisa Renaud-Walton.

The budget hearing began at 6:00pm.

Selectmen took turns reading through the articles and allowed residents to ask questions. Candidate for Road Commissioner Lisa Renaud-Walton introduced herself and answered questions from the audience.

- I. Jack called the selectmen's meeting to order at 7:20pm.
- II. Reports
 - A. Road Report: Jeremy reported that the mowing of roadsides will begin on Monday. Two paving estimates were received for the paving of a section of Church St. from Rt. 219 to Mahoney Road. Pine Tree Paving estimated \$66.09 per ton and Pike estimated \$77.50 per ton. Jack motioned to accept the estimate from Pine Tree Paving. Lee second. All in favor=3.
 - B. CEO Report: Jack moved that Bill Kennedy and Kay Hawkins will inspect an older mobile home, which has been allowed to be moved into Hartford and must comply with the mobile home ordinance within 90days, and to bring in Roger Williams if necessary. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
 - C. ACO Report: not present
- III. Old Business
 1. Insurance Proposal: Jack motioned to stay with MMA Risk Management this year. Zoe second. All in favor=3.
 2. 2006 Foreclosures: Lee motioned to sell property on Church Street back to owner Michael Whittemore with all payments for back taxes due by October 1, 2009. Jack second. All in favor=3.
 3. Health Officer compensation: Lee motioned to pay Kay Hawkins the prorated stipend for Health Officer out of the leftover funds in the Buckfield Fire Account. Jack second. All in favor=3. Selectmen directed Lianne to forget about continuing to try to collect the stipend previously paid to Sigrid Houlette for the duties of Health Officer.
 4. Unemployment Insurance: Lee motioned not to sign up or pay for unemployment insurance. Jack second. All in favor=3.
